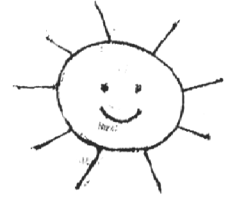

2. Project work:
 - Roll No (1 to 5)- Solar System Model: Create a scale model of the solar system using Styrofoam balls or other materials. Students can paint and label each planet, including their relative sizes and distances from the sun.
 - Roll No (6 to 10)-Water Cycle Demonstration: Build a simple water cycle model using a clear plastic container, water, and heat source (like a lamp). Students can observe condensation, precipitation, and evaporation in action as they simulate the water cycle process.
 - Roll No (11 to 15). Volcano Model: Construct a model volcano using clay or papier-mâché and simulate an eruption using baking soda and vinegar. This project allows students to learn about volcanic eruptions and the science behind them.
 - Roll No (21 to 25) Simple Machines Demonstrations: Create working models or demonstrations of simple machines such as levers, pulleys, inclined planes, screws, wedges, and wheels and axles. Students can build these models using household materials and explain how each machine works.
 - Roll No (26 to 30)Ecosystem Diorama: Build a diorama representing a specific ecosystem, such as a forest, desert, or coral reef. Students can include models of plants, animals, and other organisms found in that ecosystem, as well as label key features and interactions.
 - Roll No (31 to 35) *Electric Circuit Board*: Construct a simple electric circuit board using batteries, wires, light bulbs, and switches. Students can learn about circuit components and how electricity flows through a circuit by building and testing their own circuits.
 - Roll No (36 onwards) **Renewable Energy Demonstrations**: Create models or demonstrations of renewable energy sources such as solar panels, wind turbines, and hydroelectric dams. Students can learn about sustainable energy production and the environmental benefits of renewable energy.
