



Model Work:

• Roll No. (1 to 5) Solar Cooker: Construct a solar cooker using materials like cardboard, aluminium foil, and a transparent cover (like a plastic sheet or glass). Students can learn about solar energy and how it can be used for cooking by harnessing the power of the sun.

- Roll No. (6 to 10) Electric Motor Model: Build a simple electric motor using a battery, wire, magnet, and coil. Students can explore the principles of electromagnetism and how electrical energy can be converted into mechanical energy to produce motion.
- Roll No. (11 to 15) Greenhouse Model: Create a miniature greenhouse model to demonstrate how greenhouse gases trap heat and contribute to global warming. Students can learn about the greenhouse effect and its impact on climate change.

 digestive system using materials like clay, tubing, and containers to represent the mouth,
 esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and large intestine. Students can simulate the digestion
 process and learn about the role of enzymes and digestive juices.
